NEWS RELEASE

Warren County Treasurer, Jim Aumann, reports the second half 2016 Real Estate Tax bills have been mailed. Anyone who does not receive a bill by July 1, 2017, should contact the Warren County Treasurer's Office by letter or by phoning one of the following numbers listed below:

Lebanon: 513-695-1300

Cincinnati: 513-925-1300

The deadline for payment of real estate taxes without penalty is July 26th, 2017. To avoid penalties, payment must be received or postmarked by the July 26th due date. **(NOTE: mail dropped into the local Post Offices is no longer "Postmarked" by the local Post Offices – it could be several days before an envelope is "Postmarked" by the Regional Post Office).**

The Warren County Treasurer's Office, located in the County Administration Building, 406 Justice Dr., Lebanon, Ohio 45036, is open from 8:30AM to 4:30PM, Monday thru Friday with the exception that the Office will be closed on Tuesday, July 4th, 2017 in observance of the holiday.

In addition to being able to pay taxes on-line by credit card, taxes can now be paid on-line by electronic check ("e-check") directly from a checking account or savings account. Also, an e-mailed tax bill is now available for those who find it easier to manage their bill payment activities electronically (for more details, see the Treasurer's homepage on the County's website at www.co.warren.oh.us go to "Your Government," then click on "Treasurer").

Mr. Aumann reports that Real Estate Taxes may be paid at any of the following financial institutions:

1st National Bank - Warren County Locations
First Financial Bank - Warren County Locations
LCNB National Bank - Warren County Locations
Middletown Area Schools Credit Union
Peoples Bank - Warren County Locations
Peoples First Savings Bank - Mason & Morrow Locations

The tax bill should be brought to the financial institution and submitted with the payment. All payments made at any of the above Institutions must be the full amount due, as shown on the tax bill – no partial payments will be accepted. Any partial payments must be paid at the Warren County Treasurer's Office.
