What is an Access and Functional Needs Registry?

The Access and Functional Needs Registry helps state and local governments identify and assist individuals with Access and Functional Needs during an evacuation. It is an efficient way to catalog individuals and their needs, map the evacuation area, and deploy the essential resources. You can register yourself, a love one, or a facility. There is no cost to Warren County residents to register.

Who should register?

- People who are physically and/or mentally disabled or impaired
- Non-native English speakers
- People who are medically or chemically dependent
- Anyone living in a geographically or culturally isolated area
- People with ambulatory issues
