

Lebanon Man Gets Prison For Robbing Carry-Out

Johnathan Melton, 24, of Lebanon was sentenced to four years in prison Thursday after pleading guilty to aggravated robbery, a first degree felony. On November 20, 2014, Melton entered the A-1 Carry Out in Lebanon and brandished a knife. He demanded bath salts from the cashier.

When the cashier replied that they do not sell bath salts, Melton grabbed a carton of cigarettes and fled the store. Melton was arrested by the Lebanon Police later that week and was found in possession of heroin.
