DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

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Michael Shadoan, Facilities Management Director, was present to discuss the re-plat of the Warren County Government Campus as required by the City of Lebanon when they issued the zoning permit for the construction of the new Common Pleas Court Office Addition building.

Mr. Shadoan presented the attached PowerPoint presentation. He stated that the City has requested the private drive known as the Justice Drive extension leading to Warren County Juvenile Court and the Warren County Sheriff's Office to be provided a public access easement and also be named.

Mr. Shadoan then presented the plat showing the public access easement and naming it Memorial Drive as discussed in a previous work session with the Board.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #15-0486) to authorize the Re-Plat of the Warren County Government Campus including the naming of Memorial Drive and to recommend the new address of the Warren County Sheriff's Office as 822 Memorial Drive.

PUBLIC HEARING

HOSPITAL FACILITY REVENUE BONDS FOR MERCY HEALTH

The public hearing to consider the issuance of hospital facility revenue bonds by Allen County, Ohio for Mercy Health was convened this 31st day of March 2015, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Abbot Thayer, Dinsmore & Shoal, explained the need for the public hearing in Warren County due to the location of two Mercy Health locations in Deerfield Township that will be receiving upgrades from the issuance of the bonds.

Commissioner Young confirmed with Mr. Thayer that the issuance of these bonds creates no liability to Warren County.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #15-0487) to authorize the County of Warren, Ohio to approve the Issuance of Hospital Facilities Revenue Bonds of the County of Allen, Ohio; and authorize other documents in connection with the Issuance of such Bonds.

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Dave Gully, County Administrator, was present along with Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, for a work session to discuss the agreement provided by the Ohio Department of Development relative to the racetrack redevelopment grant application.

Mr. Gully provided background information relative to the \$3 million grant from the Ohio Department of Development for racetrack redevelopment. He then stated that the agreement presented by the State of Ohio is between the State and the City of Lebanon with Warren County signing as a collaborative partner.

There was much discussion relative the process of how the funds will be expended and the need for clarification with the City of Lebanon.

Mr. Gully confirmed that 50% of the funds will be utilized by the City of Lebanon and 50% by Warren County.

Mr. McGary reiterated that the proposed agreement is with the City of Lebanon and we are only a "sign off" signature as a collaborative partner. He then stated the significant piece will be the memorandum of understanding between the City of Lebanon and Warren County.

Upon discussion, Mr. Gully stated he will work with Pat Clements on the Memorandum of Understanding and present it the Board for discussion.

Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, stated he and Mr. Gully have an upcoming meeting with the Warren County Agricultural Society relative to a new lease for the Warren County Fairgrounds.

Commissioner Young requested clarification relative to the 16 acre parcel of land located at the Warren County Airport owned by CSW Enterprise Inc. relative to access to the runway and road frontage.

Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, provided background information relative to how the ownership transferred from CSW Enterprise Inc. to Warren County Airport, Inc. and stated that when the property was sold, CSW Enterprise Inc. transferred all rights to access the runway to Warren County Airport, Inc. He then stated that CSW Enterprise Inc. believed that they reserved their access to the runway but they did not.

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On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:35 a.m. to discuss personnel matters relative to hiring in Water/Sewer and Emergency Services and a reclassification in Children Services pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 10:55 a.m.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
