

QUALIFYING ASSISTANCE FOR THE WARREN COUNTY EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

RENT

- “Rent”- A tenant’s regular payment to a landlord for the use of property or land. This may include outstanding fees owed including but not limited to, late fees and pet fees.
- This program covers both rental arrearages and possibly future rent payments.
- All payments for rent must be supported by documentation such as a lease, bill, or other form of verification to show the amount owed by the tenant.

UTILITY

Utility Assistance and Home Energy Costs include the following.

- Electricity,
- Gas,
- Water and Sewer,
- Trash removal, and
- Energy costs, such as fuel oil,
- Internet Service (if required for remote working or remote learning),
- PIPP balances.
- All payments for utilities and home energy costs should be supported by a bill, invoice, or evidence of payment to the provider of the utility or home energy service.
- Utilities that are covered by the landlord within the rental amount will be treated as a rent payment.

Utility Assistance does not include the following.

- Telephone
- Cable
