FREE WARREN COUNTY SPRING PAPER SHREDDING AND ELECTRONICS RECYCLING EVENT!

The Warren County Records Center & Archives and the Solid Waste Department will be hosting a Combined Paper Shredding and Electronics Recycling event for the spring on Saturday, May 6th, from 10:00am to 1:00pm at the Warren County Administration Building parking lot, located at 406 Justice Drive in Lebanon.

Just like in the fall, shredding will be conducted offsite, and both shredding and electronics recycling will be first come, first serve until the trucks are full. No more than five boxes of paper will be accepted per vehicle. Staples and paper clips do not need to be removed.

This event is open to all Warren County residents with free paper shredding conducted by Royal Document Destruction.

The electronics recycling will be conducted by Cohen Recycling. *Electronic material includes TVs and computer*equipment. No more than one car trunk (or equivalent) per household will be accepted. Some larger electronics may require a small fee. Donations will be accepted for electronics recycling but is not required.
