

# Kinship Permanency Incentive Program (KPIP)

KPIP provides time-limited incentive payments to families caring for their kin.

**The eligibility requirements for the program are as follows:**

- ☀ **Must have received Legal Custody/Guardianship after July 2005.**
- ☀ **Income is not higher than 300% of the federal poverty guidelines.\*\***
- ☀ **Caregiver must live in Warren County.**
- ☀ **All adults (18 +) residing in home must provide an FBI/BCI background check.**
- ☀ **An approved home study must be completed at your residence.**

Warren County Children Services can provide you with forms to have FBI/BCI background checks completed and will assign a liaison to complete your home study. It may be your responsibility to pay for FBI/BCI background checks.

\*\*Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 5101.801 and Ohio Administrative Code rule 5101:2-40-04, the following schedule is to be used only when determining whether families are eligible to receive Kinship Permanency Incentive (KPI) payments. The schedule represents 300% of the 2021 Federal Poverty Guidelines (published in the Federal Register, Vol. 86, No. 19, February 1, 2021, pp. 7732-7734) rounded to the nearest dollar and adjusted for family size.
