DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Scott McVey, Common Pleas Court Administrator, was present to discuss the renewal applications for three grants from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation which are designed to fund programs that help reduce jail population.

Mr. McVey explained that there are renewals of the grants that the Board approved last year for Intensive Supervision, Jail Diversion and Prison Diversion. He then presented the number of

people served in lieu of jail and the estimated savings of \$1.7 million to the taxpayers because of these programs.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #10-0798, 10-1799, and 10-0800) to authorize submittal of the grant applications.

PUBLIC HEARING

ROAD NAME CHANGE OF A PORTION OF IRWIN SIMPSON ROAD TO DEERFIELD BOULEVARD IN DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP

The public hearing to consider the road name change petition to rename a portion of Irwin Simpson Road to Deerfield Boulevard was convened this 8th day of June 2010, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Dave Mick, Assistant County Engineer, presented a map of the roadway and stated that there is one property owner affected by this change. He then stated that, due to the realignment of Irwin Simpson Road, this portion has become a cul-de-sac off of Mason-Montgomery Road and is directly across from the existing Deerfield Boulevard which was created when the Irwin Simpson Road was realigned on the east side of Mason-Montgomery Road. He then stated that the one property owner which is affected by this road name change was compensated for the aggravation of changing his address during the easement acquisition process.

Upon further discussion, there being no persons present to speak in opposition to the road name change, the public hearing was closed and the Board resolved (Resolution #10-802) to approve the road name change of a portion of Irwin Simpson Road to Deerfield Boulevard in Deerfield Township.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:00 a.m. to discuss personnel matters within Children Services pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 10:45 a.m.

Jerry Haddix, Grants Coordinator, was present for the Board to announce their selection of an operator for the Warren County Transit Services.

Mr. Haddix stated that, upon review of the Request for Proposals, Winton Transportation came in with the lowest proposal.

The Board stated their appreciation for the great working relationship and dedicated service they provided to the citizens of Warren County by MV Transit. They then stated their desire for Winton Transportation to make the transition process from one provider to the other as smooth as possible and to please consider utilizing as many current employees as possible.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #10-810) adopted to select Winton Transportation LLC as the operator of the Warren County Transit Service and approve Notice of Intent to enter into Agreement.

Vicky Perry, Grants Coordinator, was present to explain the Neighborhood Stabilization Homebuyer Assistance Agreement with Mr. and Mrs. Wood.

Mrs. Perry stated that Mr. and Mrs. Wood has completed all the required steps and qualify for assistance and are purchasing a foreclosed property from the bank with the assistance of these grant funds.

Commissioner Young stated his desire for a work session to discuss his desire to continue with programs such as these but stated that he will vote in favor of entering into this agreement as these people are "in process".

Commissioner Kilburn stated his opposition to these types of programs.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #10-0811) adopted to approve and authorize the President of Vice President of this Board to enter into Loan Agreement with William David Wood and Andrea Christine Wood, Husband and Wife, relative to the Warren County Neighborhood Stabilization Program with Commissioner Kilburn voting nay.
