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DISCUSSIONS			
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On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Commissioner Young commended Governor Kasich and the State Legislatures for overcoming the tremendous budget deficient and approving the budget. He stated he was pleased that the Caesar Creek Marina funding was restored in the budget but stated his disappointment with the lodgings tax increase authority not being included as well as the "racino" 50-mile radius rule not being added to the budget language which will mean the loss of many jobs for Warren County due to the need for Lebanon Raceway to relocate outside the Dayton Market.

There was discussion relative to the lodgings tax authority language and Commissioner South stated that it will need to be a stand alone bill that will hopefully be approved this year.

Walt Davis and Jim Voorhis, Area Progress Council, was present along with representatives from the Warren County Park Board and Jeff Blazey, Lebanon resident who has constructed and donated a telescope that will allow the Gulley Park and Trail on Middleboro Road to become the Warren County Observatory.

Jim Voorhis, Area Progress Council Project Chair, presented a PowerPoint presentation explaining the proposed project.

Mr. Blazey stated that the telescope is currently located on Liberty Keuter Road and will be relocated once the Observatory is constructed. He then explained that, due to the location of the proposed Observatory, Warren County will have a better Observatory then Cincinnati or Dayton.

The Board then questioned how the telescope was built and commended Mr. Blazey for his heartfelt donation to the Warren County residents.

Mr. Voorhis presented the proposal to construction a 660 square foot building that includes a "warm room" and storage facility that has the ability to be turned into a future restroom. He then showed a computer generated picture of the proposed finish facility that includes a picnic area as well as a patio for residents to bring their own telescopes to the facility.

Mr. Voorhis then presented the project valuation figures as follows:

Mr. Voorhis then provided the actual Project Grant Total due to the following donations:

Mr. Davis stated they will begin fundraising activities very soon. He stated the goal to have the funds raised prior to September so that the WCCC Class of 2012 can construct the project. He then requested the Board to consider a 2 to 1 match of the funds raised.

Commissioner Young stated his full support of this project and committed to purchase a brick for the patio with a personal donation of \$1000 but stated that with the budget uncertain at this point relative to cuts from the State and Federal government, County government cannot be counted on as an "easy match". He then stated his personal feeling that they will have no problem coming up with the amount needed through private donations.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
