Neil Tunison, Warren County Engineer, and Mike Shadoan, Director, Warren County Facilities Management will review bid for a recommendation at a later date.

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, was present for a work session and discussed the following matters:

- Waynesville Wastewater Agreement—Staff has come to the conclusion that a need exists
 to create a regional sewer district between Warren County and the Village of
 Waynesville, like we have in Franklin. Mr. Brausch stated it will take approximately 9
 months to a year to have the district in place and fully functioning and recommended the
 Board consider a 4th extension to the existing agreement until that time. Upon discussion,
 the Board agreed.
- 2. RFQ for Massie-Wayne Sewer System Upgrade—Staff has received the qualifications from interested engineering firms and has ranked the applicants. Upon discussion, the Board determined that staff should interview the top 3 or 4 companies and make a recommendation to the Board.
- 3. Manchester Road Waterline Replacement Design—Ohio Public Works Commission has funded this project for 2013 and the Board needs to hire an engineering firm to begin the design of the project. Mr. Brausch stated that the scope is under the formal RFQ

- requirement threshold. Upon discussion, the Board directed Mr. Brausch to begin negotiation with R.A. Consulting for the project.
- 4. Lytle Elevated Tank Color—a few residents have concern relative to the tower color. Upon discussion, the Board agreed to the normal paint colors of white on the bottom and a lighter shade of blue on the top.
- 5. OWEA would like Warren County to sponsor the regional meeting which does not require any money but rather a tour of the Lower Little Miami Wastewater Treatment Plant. Upon discussion, the Board approved the request.
- 6. OTCO—as employees within the Water Department are authorized to take training classes to obtain their operator's license, the employee is required to pay the \$500 cost up front and be reimbursed upon completion of the class. Mr. Brausch stated he would like to amend the policy to pay for the class up front and have the employee reimburse the county if the course is not completed. The Board approved the request.
- 7. Bond Retirement—Mrs. Solinski, Business Manager, informed the Board of a December 1st call date on a \$4.5 million bond. She stated that she has the funds to pay off the bond in surplus and that the rate of the bond is between 4 5%. She stated that we may need to short term finance an upcoming project but the current borrowing rate is around 2%. The Board agreed to the pay off of the bond.
- 8. Mr. Brausch informed the Board that the projects at the Water Treatment Plant being done in conjunction with the Warren County Career Center is complete and provided pictures of the work completed by the High School Welding Class.

Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, was present to discuss a concern of a constituent relative to a culvert being installed on a private lot in order to gain access to construct a new home that may have the potential to cause water problems to the adjacent lots.

Mr. Spurling stated that upon his investigation and consultation with the Prosecutor's Office, the County has no authority to intervene as this is a private property matter.

Commissioner Young requested Mr. Spurling call the concerned constituent and explain the situation.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:30 a.m. to discuss personnel matters pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 11:15 a.m.
