PUBLIC HEARING SITE PLAN REVIEW APPLICATION OF CAMP KERN IN WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP

The public hearing to consider the site plan review application of Camp Kern in Washington Township to request approval to relocate and construct a replica of the Hart School Building was convened this 4th day of June 2013, in the Commissioners Meeting Room.

Commissioner Ariss confirmed with the Clerk of Commissioners and the Zoning Supervisor that all required notices were completed and requested the Zoning Supervisor to present the request.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Supervisor, stated that the intended use of the Hart School Replica building is to demonstrate a historic classroom operation of the 1800's. He stated that children will sit and be instruction on the 1800 curriculum and procedures and that the building will also be used to recreate the Underground Railroad scenarios.

Bob Reynolds, Camp Kern, was present to answer any questions the Board may have.

Upon discussion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the public hearing was closed and the Board resolved (Resolution #13-0826) to approve the site plan review application.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Supervisor, reviewed the location of the property and the property owners within the rezoning area and stated that the Rural Zoning Commission approved a modification of the application to rezone the approximate 4.9 acre parcel to be rezoned to Rural Residence "R-1A" with the removal of the interstate highway overlay.

Commissioner Ariss confirmed that there was no one present to speak in favor of or in opposition to the rezoning application.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #13-0832) to approve the modification of the rezoning application initiated by the Warren County Board of Commissioners to consider the rezoning of approximately 16.292 acres (parcel # 13234000060, 1322000080, 13222000170, 13222000160, and the western portion of 13222000032) in Turtlecreek from Light Industrial "I-1" with an Interstate Highway Overlay to Neighborhood Commercial Business "B-1" with an Interstate Highway Overlay and approximately 4.9 acres (Parcel # 1322200031 and the eastern portion of 13222000032) in Turtlecreek Township from Light Industrial "I-1" with an Interstate Highway Overlay to Rural Residence "R-1A".
