Judge Kirby, Probate-Juvenile Court, was present along with the Probate and Juvenile Court Department Heads and Michael Shadoan, Facilities Management Director, for a work session to discuss the Probate-Juvenile Court Long Range Plans.

Judge Kirby presented the attached Long Range Plan spreadsheets and stated the need for improvements and updates within the facilities. He then stated the possibility of a 60/40 reimbursable grant opportunity through the Department of Young Services (DYS) for improvements within the Detention Area of the building.

Dave Gully, County Administrator, stated his recommendation to fund the improvements \$100,000 a year until completed.

Mr. Shadoan informed those present that the roof repairs are in line to be completed as well as the window glazing and that the HVAC improvements are in process.

Judge Kirby reviewed the list of needed improvements and upon discussion, the Board requested Mr. Shadoan to work with Tony Miller, Superintendant of Juvenile Detention, on a list of improvements and cost associated with the improvements in order to apply for the grant from DYS.
