Tom Sparks, Impact Group, stated his firm is a marketing, survey and polling firm that has been hired to help define the wants and needs of Warren County's population by conducting telephone and online survey. He then stated that once the telephone survey is completed, they would schedule one-on-one focus groups with city, village and township representatives to help further define the needs of Warren County.

The Board of Commissioners reviewed the proposed survey questions and made changes/suggestions of specific things that they feel are important to focus on in the survey.

Upon discussion, it was determined that the consultant will amend the questions, conduct the telephone survey and upon completion, the Park Board will schedule another work session with the Board to provide the results and what the next step in the process should be.
