DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present along with Chuck Petty, Assistant Engineer, and Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, to discuss a drainage concern relative to ta resident in Harlan Township.

Mr. McGary provided background information relative to the letter received from Wendy VonBlon as well as the Ohio Revised Code section that relates to ditches. He then provided a legal opinion on the validity of the submitted letter as it does not contain the necessary items to be considered a "petition".

Mr. Tunison stated that he has worked with this property owner since the early 1990's. He reviewed the location of the property and stated that the owner has inquired about the availability

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of Ohio Public Works Commission grant funding. He stated that he reviewed the request and determined that the project does not rank high enough to be considered for funding.

There was then discussion relative to the possibility of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to provide improvements.

Susanne Mason, Program Manager, stated that the area income exceeds the maximum allowed for the utilization of CDBG funds and short of an income survey showing otherwise, any project that the Harlan Township Trustees chose to submit for this area would not be eligible.

There was discussion relative to the process of a ditch petition and the requirement for the benefited property owner to be assessed any cost for improvements over a fifteen year time period. It was also determined that the project cost cannot outweigh the benefit of the improvement to the property.

Mrs. Mason discussed the CDBG application eligibility as well as the concern from the property owner relative to the funding of improvements to her home. She reviewed her discussion with Mrs. VonBlon relative to the home rehabilitation loan program as well as the requirement of a property lien to ensure repayment. She stated that the property owner was not interested in any program that would require a property lien.

Upon discussion, the Board stated the determination that the letter received from the homeowner does not constitute the filing of a ditch petition, that the use Ohio Public Works Commission funding is not a viable option due to ranking and the area does not qualify for CDBG funding without an income survey.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present for a work session to discuss a bridge replacement project on Townsley and Everett Drive in Deerfield Township.

Mr. Tunison presented plans and a map providing the location of the project and discussed the need for the improvements as well as the temporary and drainage easements required.

The Board discussed how homeowners will access their property during construction.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #18-1220) to determine the necessity for a certain road and bridge improvement project for public use without charge where special assessments are not to be levied or collected, to be known as the Townsley Drive Bridge #1201-0.50 and Everett Avenue Bridge #2032-0.23 Replacement Projects in Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
