SEPTEMBER 3, 2019

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Susan Spencer, Personnel Officer, was present to introduce various newly hired employees.

Susan Spencer, Personnel Officer, was present along with Tammy Whitaker, Benefits Administrator, for a work session to discuss various amendments to the Warren County Personnel Policy.

Mrs. Spencer stated that some of the amendments are to "clean up" language however there is one change for consideration that would be a workers compensation policy change.

Mrs. Spencer explained the current policy relative to temporary total disability where we pay the state assigned maximum benefit. She explained that any employee making a wage higher than the stated assigned maximum takes a pay cut from being injured on the job. She then presented the proposal to allow an employee with sick leave accrual the ability to utilize sick leave in order to "buy up" their compensation to equal their regular wage which also allows them to receive PERS credit during their leave.

The Board discussed the proposed change in policy relative to the positives and negatives.
