DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, was present for a work session and discussed the following:

1, Biosolids Study—Mr. Brausch discussed the opportunity to be included in a joint study relative to the need/efficiency for a regional biosolids processing facility that would process biosolids from Butler, Greene, Montgomery, and Warren County. He stated the proposed study would be at a cost not to exceed \$100,000 for the hiring of an engineering firm to study the need and the proposed cost.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #19-1490) to enter into a memorandum of understanding for a cost not to exceed \$25,000 with Butler, Greene, and Montgomery Counties.

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2. Plainview Acres Sanitary Sewer Assessment Study Update—Mr. Brausch presented background information on the history of the proposed project relative to providing sanitary sewer for Plainview Acres in Deerfield Township. He discussed the most recent study on the most cost-efficient way to provide sewers to the remaining area (approximately 25 homes).

Commissioner Young stated his opposition to pump stations but questioned if there is a way to pump the sewage to Charleston Park Subdivision.

Mr. Brausch stated that the most economical route is to pipe down Butler Warren Road to connect to Butler County's sewer system. He then stated that the proposed assessment would be \$18,000 - \$22,000 per home.

Upon further discussion, the Board directed Mr. Brausch to meet with the property owners "pushing" for the project to discuss the cost prior to issuing the findings in a letter to all the residents.

3. Red Lion Sewer Study Area—Mr. Brausch stated that the Clearcreek Township Trustees hired an engineer for a sewer study for the Red Lion Area. Mr. Brausch stated that the trustees have a meeting planned for Wednesday to provide an update on the project with expended final results expected the 1st quarter of 2020.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present for a work session to discuss the Red Lion Five Points Road/Bunnell Hill/Lytle Five Points Road intersection area.

Commissioner Jones provided background information relative to the October 24, 2019, Commissioners' meeting with Stephanie Roeder where she discussed her concerns relative to the road realignment along with her desire for the County Engineer to move the proposed roadway alignment to the other side of the property which Warren County purchased for the road right of way.

Mr. Tunison presented drawings of the current alignment as well as the proposed realignment including the new roundabout. He then discussed the desire to reduce the speed for the approach to the new roundabout and stated it is not possible to relocate the alignment to the other side of the house due to the need for additional road right of way from the adjacent property owner.

Upon further discussion, the Board stated that Mrs. Roeder will be at the November 14, 2019, Commissioner Meeting to discuss this project.

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Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
