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#### INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Warren County Board of Commissioners in the Commissioner's conference room at the Warren County Administration Building, 406 Justice Drive, Lebanon, Ohio 45036 until 9:00 a.m. local time on August 9, 2016 and will be publicly opened and read at that place and time for the following work at the **2016 Improvements to Warren County Airport - Lane Field Rehabilitate Taxiway Pavement Project**, including asphalt pavement milling, full depth asphalt pavement removal, asphalt concrete base, intermediate and surface courses, bituminous tack coat, pavement marking, reflective media, temporary airfield markers, berming, seeding, mulching, and other incidental items of work.

Copies of the Contract Documents containing all the forms and requirements are available to prospective bidders at the offices of Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., 1500 Lake Shore Drive, Suite 100, Columbus, Ohio 43204, upon non-refundable payment of \$75 per set. Checks are to be made payable to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. Bidders must obtain a hard copy of the Bid Documents from Stantec, and bids must be submitted on the Proposal Forms contained in these Bid Documents.

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond for 100 percent of the bid or by a certified check, or a cashier's check, on a solvent bank in the amount of 10 percent of the bid. If a check is submitted, a separate Contract Bond for One Hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the contract, with a satisfactory surety or sureties, will then be required from the successful bidder for the faithful performance of the work.

Attention of the bidder is called to the statutory requirements of the State of Ohio relative to licensing of corporations organized under the laws of any other state. The bidder will be required to state in full detail, on their bid, their experience in the type of work for which they are submitting a bid. Bids from contractors inexperienced in the particular class of work for which they are bidding will not be considered.

Work will be subject to the following state requirements: Delinquent Property Tax Requirements and State Prevailing Wage Rates. Work will be subject to the following federal requirements: Civil Rights - General; Civil Rights - Title VI Assurances; Federal Fair Labor Standards Act; and Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970;

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the bid packet. No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. All bids shall be properly signed by an authorized representative of the bidder.

Award of work, if it is awarded, will be made to the lowest and best bidder whose proposal complies with all
requirements prescribed. The right is reserved to waive any informalities or technical defects, as the interests of the
Warren County Commissioners may require, or to reject any or all proposals. No award will be made if it exceeds
the Engineer's Estimate by more than 10 percent.
