\* ORDER FOR PARENTING CLASS

Pursuant to Local Rule 4.2, parents of minor children under the age of sixteen (16) seeking a divorce, dissolution, or legal separation must attend a parenting class for divorcing or separating parents prior to the filing of their final Decree. However, given the COVID-19 pandemic, the Warren County Domestic Relations Court in-person parenting classes are currently suspended.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of the filing of this Order, both parties shall register for and successfully complete an on-line parenting class for divorcing parents. The following list contains acceptable classes:


If you wish to attend a different class, you must call the Court at 513-695-2586 with the name and website link of the class and obtain approval in advance to attend your proposed class.
