# **Correction Officer Ciera Greene**

It was with deep sorrow the Warren County Sheriff's Office announced the loss of Corrections Officer Ciera Greene. Just after midnight on November 12, 2014, Officer Greene was involved in a single car crash after completing her tour of duty. She sustained life ending injuries.

Her selfless duty and call to serve did not end there as she was kept on life support so she could donate her organs to others. She passed away with family and friends by her side on Saturday, November 15, 2014 at approximately 2:00 P.M. She was 23 years old.

Officer Greene received a bachelor degree in criminal justice and Jewish studies from Kent State University in 2012. She became a member of the Warren County Sheriff's Office in February 2013. Officer Greene was an exceptionally driven person and stellar corrections officer who made everlasting impressions on those she served with. Her passion for law enforcement continued as she entered into the police academy in September of this year to fulfill her dream of becoming a Warren County Deputy Sheriff.

We at Warren County Emergency Services offer our sincere condolences to the Warren County Sheriff's Office and the family and friends of Ciera. We dedicate this edition of the newsletter to her.

### **Notification List**

That time of the year is here! We will be paging out road crews more often and it's imperative that we have correct information. We are asking all agencies to check the phone numbers and names on their notification list and if updates are needed please let us know. Thanks for your help with this!!

### **Reminder for the Upcoming Winter**

We all know that crashes and disabled vehicles will be on the rise during the winter months. During hazardous road conditions it is not uncommon for a driver to leave their vehicle until the roads clear and/or they can get help to remove it. This causes a lot of repeat calls for the same disabled vehicle. We are asking that officers and firefighters tie yellow caution tape around the side mirror of the vehicle that is facing the roadway. This helps when dispatchers are taking these types of calls. They will ask if the caller sees caution tape on the vehicle. If the caller says they see the tape then the dispatcher knows that we have already been out with the vehicle and there is no need to send anyone out. For several years now this practice has reduced unnecessary calls and dispatches.

# **Call of the Month**

On Thursday morning, November 20<sup>th</sup> just after beginning her shift, Dispatcher Samantha Hall took a 911 call from an 11-yearold girl whose father was not breathing. The grandmother could be heard crying hysterically in the background while the 11year-old answered all of Samantha's questions. She walked the young girl through CPR instructions on her 34-year-old father. Hall helped the child to remain calm, explaining to her everything that was happening, instructing her as to what she needed to do, and reassuring her throughout the process until Harlan Township units arrived on the scene.

Blanchester Paramedics were requested for assistance while Harlan units continued CPR. The male was transported to Bethesda Arrow Springs by Blanchester where, unfortunately, he was pronounced. Dispatcher Hall did a good job talking to the 11-year-old caller and instructing her on CPR. Great job to Samantha!
